

MARRIAGE CONDITIONS CERTIFICATE

1. Miscellaneous Services form for Indian nationals
2. Sworn -Affidavit for general statement.
The forms can be downloaded from <https://indianembassybrussels.gov.in/applicationform.php>
3. Three passport size photographs (size 5.0 cm x 5.0 cm with light background showing front view of face). One of the photos is to be pasted on the application form. The remaining photographs should be submitted intact (please DO NOT staple the photos or sign them over).
4. Self-attested Photocopy of the current passport, including endorsements, if any, done by Indian Passport Issuing Authorities. Original Passport to be shown at the counter.
5. Self-attested Photocopy of the Residence Permit in Luxembourg. Original Resident Permit to be shown at the counter.
6. Self-attested Passport and Residence Permit copy of the future spouse or partner. Original to be shown at the counter.
7. A certificate from the commune where marriage or PACS is being registered.
8. A bachelorhood or single status certificate from India, duly apostilled. Please see the link below <https://mea.gov.in/bachelorhood-single-status-certificate.htm>
9. A bachelorhood or single status certificate of the future spouse or partner. If the future spouse or partner is Indian, then from India, duly apostilled. If the future spouse or partner is of any other nationality, then from the Commune where he/she is residing and duly apostilled by the Foreign Ministry of Belgium/Luxembourg.
10. Address proof of Luxembourg Ex; Telephone Bill, water Bill, Electricity Bill or certificate de Residence from the Commune
11. Prescribed Fee € 17 + € 2 ICWF surcharge Plus € 15 Courier charges apply

Steps for Photo Edit:

1. Open the photo in the Photos application and click on Edit.
2. Crop the image so that the head/face occupies approximately 80–85% of the frame.
3. Open the same photo in the Paint application.
4. Select Resize and Skew.
5. Set the dimensions to 830 × 810 pixels.
6. Click the Maintain Aspect Ratio (blue lock) icon to apply the size correctly, then save the image.
7. Open the saved photo, click on the three dots, and select Resize image.
8. Save the photo ensuring the file size is less than 100 KB.
